



## What is KeyRing?



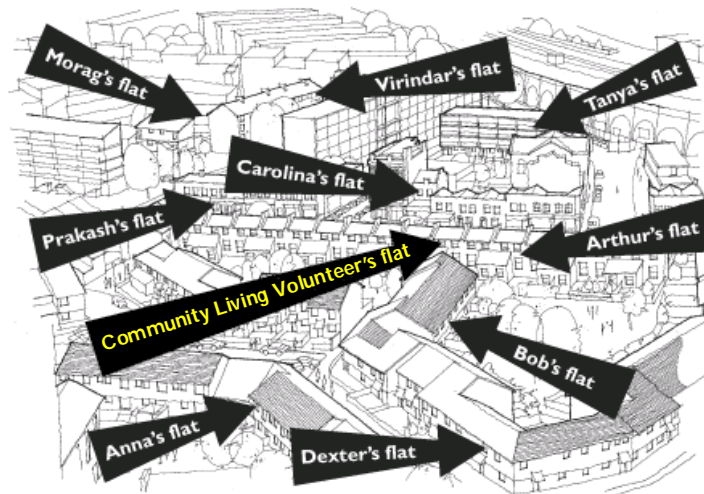
- People were saying they wanted their own place to live

## People can share skills & support each other



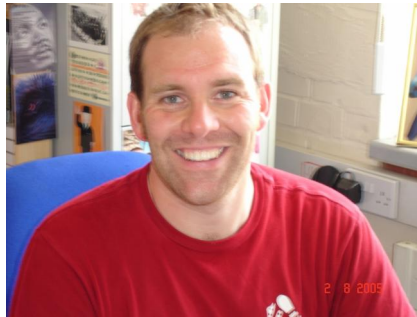
## Community Living Volunteer
